The Duchy of Cornwall

The Duchy of Cornwall is a private estate which funds the public, charitable and private activities of The Prince of Wales and his family. The Duchy consists of around 53,154 hectares of land in 24 counties, mostly in the South West of England.

The Duchy estate was created in 1337 by Edward III for his son and heir, Prince Edward. A charter ruled that each future Duke of Cornwall would be the eldest surviving son of the Monarch and the heir to the throne.

The current Duke of Cornwall, HRH The Prince of Wales, is actively involved in running the Duchy and his philosophy is to improve the estate and pass it on to future Dukes in a stronger and better condition.

Main Purpose of Role

The manager will be required to lead, organise, motivate, manage and direct all operational activities of plant retail sales and staff on a day to day basis.

Scope of role

The manager will be responsible for:

- Setting and achieving objectives for a viable retail plant business in tandem with the successful existing catering and merchandise business;
- Analysing yields, operational costs and financial returns of horticultural operations to ensure achievement of overall business objectives and performance targets;
- Identifying technical and business problems, investigating the causes and formulating solutions;
- Planning and organising trials to assess their effectiveness;
- Preparing new or modified operational and business plans ensuring continual improvement;
- Developing new products and markets and negotiating with suppliers and buyers and attending national exhibitions to accommodate market trends;
- Managing produce supply chain systems and the supporting infrastructure for processing, storage and transport of produce;
- Managing the sourcing, stocking policy, quality of stock and presentation standards of a high class shopping environment;
- Organising presentations, technical visits and demonstrations.
- To ensure a safe working environment for employees, customers and visitors.
- Ensuring that UK, European Community and international quality, hygiene, health and safety and employment standards and regulations are communicated, understood and met;
- Communicating effectively with customers, fellow work colleagues and professional groups, both orally and in writing, through briefings, reports and presentations;
- Disseminating information and setting individual targets and objectives for the
- Organising staff rotas and ensuring adequate cover,
- Training and instructing staff and helping them to develop their professional skills and experience;
- Performing essential administration, including records, budgets, accounts and knowledge of EPOS system;
- Keep up to date in your specialist area and in developments in the whole horticultural sector;

effectively to the achievement of the business aims and objectives.
